- Conducts the Chancel Choir at the First Presbyterian Church of Houston



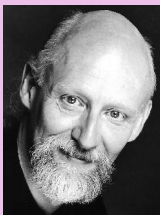
Dr. Kay Bessler Northcutt—Worship

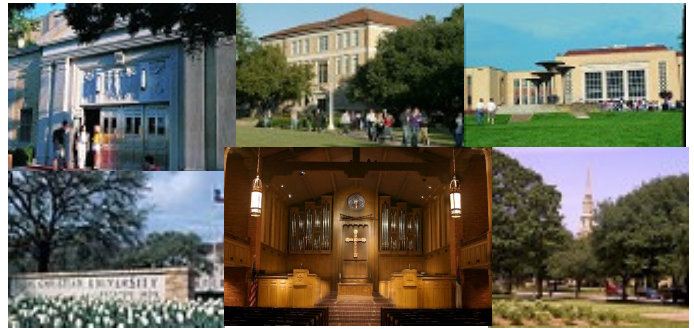
