Becoming a Green Chalice Church Rev. Daniel U'Ren

the chords learned to play songs and offering basic techniques for leading music in a church setting. While designed for students without experience on guitar, the class will seek to help those with some experience move to the next level.

Recorders can be useful in worship and helpful when teaching children or adults
