## More about the clincians.....



**Jeffrey Hon** is the founding pastor of New Song Church, a new church start in the Greater Kansas City region, established in 2006. In his current role as Co-Pastor and Music Director, he has developed a much greater sense of emergent worship – mixing contemporary worship styles with historical liturgy and ritual. Jeff has often been guest preacher, speaker and performer in many churches of varying denominational affiliations.

His undergraduate education was from William Jewell College with dual majors in Music and Business Administration. From there, he spent the next sixteen years serving as Music Director for churches in the Greater Kansas City area, including Independence Boulevard Christian Church, Liberty Christian Church, and Park

Hill Christian Church; and was active in the KC ADM Chapter. In 2002, he returned to the academic world and felt the call to enter seminary, earning his MDiv from Saint Paul School of Theology. While at Saint Paul, he served as a licensed pastor in the Greater Kansas City region of the CC (DoC) before being fully ordained in the spring of 2006. Jeff has extensive experience in church music and creative worship architecture. Additionally, he performs regularly in

Kansas City as a baritone soloist and has performed with groups such as the Fine Arts Chorale, Kansas City Chorale, Kansas City Symphony Chorus, and Musica Vocale. He enjoys spending his spare time as a builder and technician of area pipe organs.

Jeff lives in Liberty with his wife and two children. He is excited to once again be working with for his ADM colleagues and sharing his love of the Church and its music.



**Tim Whitmer** is the spirited Master of Ceremonies, and resident pianist for the Community Christian Church Jazz Carol Fest which he created along with the Reverend Robert L. Hill eighteen years ago. Tim hosts the monthly concert series *Spirituality and All That Jazz* at Unity Temple on the Plaza and serves as musical director for the Community Christian Church Journey Band. He performs regularly at top jazz venues in Kansas City.

While in training as a classical pianist at UMKC Conservatory of Music, an introduction to the highly acclaimed pianist and educator George Salisbury was the major turning point in his career to the world of Kansas City

Swing Jazz. From those experiences, he honed his own unique style and has treated audiences all over the world to a taste of Kansas City Jazz. He has performed for festivals both nationally and internationally including the Lugano and Montreaux Jazz Festivals in Switzerland.

To date, his greatest musical accomplishment was a special concert of his original music at the Weill Recital Hall at Carnegie Hall.

She directs FCC's Chancel Choir, Children's Choir and FCC's adult handbell ensemble, *Ring of Glory*, and oversees a part-time Assistant Music Director/organist and pianist. Dana has also directed choirs and ensembles at area, regional and national assemblies of the Christian Church (DoC), and has led singing, handbells and dance groups for camps, conferences and retreats.

Dana is founding director of *MosaicSong*, a non-profit community women's vocal ensemble founded 16 years ago under *The* 

*Women's Chorus of Dallas* and now associated with *Resounding Harmony* of Dallas. She served two years as Associate Music Director of The Women's Chorus of Dallas with Dr. Timothy Seelig, and then as Artistic Director of the same ensemble for one year.

Dana recently served on the boards for the Dallas Chapter of Choristers Guild and the Greater Dallas Handbell Association. Dana is an active member of American Choral Directors Association and ADM. Dana holds bachelors degrees in Voice Performance and Vocal Music Education from Phillips University in Oklahoma and has done extensive doctoral studies in conducting and musicology at the University of North Texas in Denton, TX. She is married to the Reverend Alan Lobaugh, and they have three children, a daughter, Hannah, and two sons, Benjamin and Aaron.
